### **ANNEXES**

### ANNEX 1 - MANDATORY CONDITIONS

- 1. Every supply of alcohol under this premises licence must be made or authorised by the management committee.
- 2. The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises. In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises:

- (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
- (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective [words added];
- (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective [words added];
- (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
- (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).
- 3. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- 4. The premises licence holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol. The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either a holographic mark, or an ultraviolet feature.
- 5. The responsible person must ensure that where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures:

(a) beer or cider: ½ pint;

(b) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25ml or 35ml; and

(c) still wine in a glass: 125ml;

These measures must be displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises and if a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

6. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price. For the purposes of this condition 'duty' is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979; 'permitted price' is the price found by applying the formula -  $P = D + (D \times V)$  where;  $P = D + (D \times V)$  where; P = D + (

The permitted price must be rounded up to the nearest penny.

A change to the permitted price which would apply as a result of a change to the rate of duty or VAT charged in relation to alcohol would not apply until the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the day on which the change in the rate of duty or VAT takes effect.

7. The admission of children to film exhibitions is to be restricted in accordance with the recommendations of the British Board of Film Classification (BBFC) or the Borough Council of King's Lynn & West Norfolk.

### ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

- 8. Event hirers shall sign as part of a booking arrangement that they are aware and understand the location of fire extinguishers, fire exits and fire assembly points.
- 9. A notice is to be prominently displayed at all exits reminding people to be respectful of the village hall's neighbours and leave the premises and area in an orderly manner.
- 10. A challenge 25 policy age verification must be in place at the premises in relation to the sale of alcohol.
- 11. An Incident and refusals register must be maintained and kept at the premises, to be made available to an authorised officer upon reasonable request.
